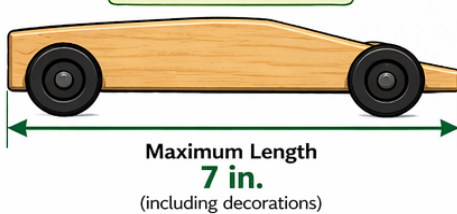
Design Specifications

When registering for this year's Sisterhood Speedway, you selected a car kit. You're encouraged to modify and decorate your kit to make it your own. However, cars should be **designed (with age-appropriate help)** by Girl Scouts and must meet the **following requirements** to ensure they fit properly, move smoothly on the track, and provide a safe and fair race for all participants.

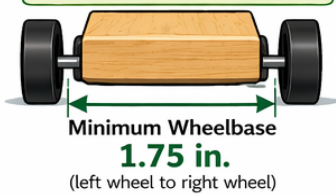
TOP VIEW (WIDTH)

Note: All rules must be met for your car to pass inspection.

KEY RULES

- 1 Each car must be built from the **kit** selected during registration.
- 2 The **total weight** of the car shall not **exceed 5.0 ounces**.
- 3 The **overall width** of the car, including decorations, shall not exceed **2.75 in.**
- 4 The **overall length** of the car, including decorations, shall not exceed **7 in.**
- 5 The **distance between** the left and right wheels shall be at least **1.75 in.**
- 6 The **wheels** provided with the kit may not be modified in any way.
- 7 The **axles** supplied with the kit must be used. They may be polished or lubricated, but only with dry lubricants (e.g., graphite). Oil-based lubricants are not permitted.
- 8 The car may not use any **type of springs** or suspension system.
- 9 Wheel bearings, washers, and bushings are prohibited.
- 10 There must be material at the center front of the car to allow the track starting pin to properly hold the car in position at the starting line.
- 11 The car must be free-wheeling and powered only by gravity. No starting devices are allowed.
- 12 All decorations must be securely attached and must not interfere with the track or other cars.
